Tyler Renaud completed his third year as head coach for the Lady Cadets, finishing off the 2007 campaign with a 13-5-1 record and ranked 19<sup>th</sup> in the NCAA Division III New England Region. The 13 wins are the most in the programs 23 year history. His overall record is 57-30-9. The Lady Cadets have qualified for the GNAC Conference Tournament each of his three years at the helm, reaching the semi-finals in 2005 and 2007.

Coach Renaud previously coached at Cayuga Community College, in Auburn, NY. Renaud turned an upstart women's soccer program into a two-time Mid State Athletic Conference Champion and NJCAA Tournament participants in each of his two years. He was twice recognized as MSAC Coach of the Year (2003, 2004) and NJCAA Region III Coach of the Year (2003).

Coach Renaud will be entering his third year at the helm of the women's lacrosse program as they head into the Great Northeast Athletic Conference play in March. His overall record is 34-14. The Lady Cadets were semi-finalists of the NEWLA Conference Lacrosse Tournament in 2007, finishing off their initial NCAA Division III campaign 7-5, with Coach Renaud being recognized as the New England Women's Lacrosse Alliance Coach of the Year.

Coach Renaud's Cayuga Lacrosse teams made the NJCAA National Final Four in his two years as the head coach. Also two time MSAC Champions, Coach Renaud was recognized as the conference Coach of the Year in 2004, along with the NJCAA Region III Coach of the Year in 2004 and the NJCAA National District C Coach of the Year in 2005.

Coach Renaud is a graduate of SUNY Fredonia and a three year letter winner in soccer. He obtained his Master's Degree from LeMoyne College in business administration.
